Shipping:

In our last letter we shared with you that we had received the container of literature. A good bit of it was sent to the northern border where it is available to brethren we have never interacted with before. Missionary Nat Williams is working with several of these men, and they are getting the literature distributed. He is teaching them and they are spreading the Gospel. Seems like I read about that somewhere... Oh yeah, in the Bible!



You may not understand the logistics of how these materials are disbursed. Here are a few pictures Nat sent to me: By pickup truck, by motorcycle, on foot, God's Word will not return void.

There is a tremendous shortage of Burmese Bibles at this point. Please pray that a supply will become available and this good work can continue.

Internet Ministry:

We now have the Bible formatted and on websites: Urdu, Russian, Bulgarian, Thai, and English. We also have Samoan, Spanish, and Portuguese ready for their sites. This is not simple as uploading the Bible to a website.

Let me explain...The interactive system we have developed utilizes the Bible text in study courses. When a Bible reference is "hovered over" with a mouse or touched on a smartphone, the Bible text pops up to be read. Also, links on each page points to a place where someone can simply read the Bible. Believe me, telling you about it took a whole lot shorter time than formatting and coding to make it happen.

One of the languages mentioned above is a new translation which has only had a small printing as it was proofread. The first time many will see it will be on this site. We are finally realizing that which we have worked on for many months.

I personally have formatted each of the abovementioned Bibles, but we now have at least one other co-worker trained to prepare these texts. As exciting as this is, it is only one aspect of making the websites do everything we envisioned. Please pray

for laborers. There is a great need of another God-called web developer who can work alongside our main developer in coding for the web.

Literature outreach in Bulgaria:

This month starts an outreach in Varna, Bulgaria in conjunction with the *European Youth Capital 2017*. This event is held in a different country each year and draws hundreds of thousands. Missionary Jeff Shergalis saw the opportunity and shared a vision to reach out to youth from all over the EU visiting his city this summer. We helped him get some of the literature for this outreach and are working with him now to have three of the newly launched websites ready for those who respond to the literature. He has teams coming to help with the distribution. Please pray for this outreach. Actually, I planned to be there now, but the next section of this letter will let you know why I am not.

Health:

We are oftentimes reminded of the value and efficacy of intercessory prayer in our lives and ministry. Even when we do not understand why the Lord directs in a particular manner or allows events which we consider troublesome, He always has a purpose.

As an example, somewhere around 2005-2006 a fellow missionary and I were driving north from Bangkok in a pickup truck when we were cut off by another vehicle. The highway was wet and this caused us to go into a spin and land in a ditch right side up after a rollover. The other missionary was fine, but my neck was compressed and it was very painful. I was put into an ambulance and taken back to Bangkok and examined at in a hospital there. They found nothing that required treatment.

Jump forward to June 2017 when a Dr., reading an MRI, said that I have one vertebrae severely out of place in my neck and there is no treatment such as injections, therapy, Chiropractic, etc., which will fix this other than immediate surgery.
