

UPDATE ON INDOCHINA OUTREACH

Much of the literature for Indochina has been proofed and is in the hands of the printers. This material includes Tracts, Gospels, Correspondence Courses, Discipleship lessons, and books such as "The Trail of Blood."

Various of these publications are in Thai, Burmese, Kachin, Lao, Hmong, Khmer, and Vietnamese. Each of the tracts are newly written in the country specifically for the people there. They are not translations of tracts used in America. Taking this approach the material will be more likely to "Hit the Mark."

Now that the material is in the hands of the printers we are trying to pin down the time that the first shipment can be made. We are still shooting for the first part of this October, but that will

depend on how quickly we can get the materials back from the printers. We will have a better handle on it around the first of September.


Shipment Funds...

Funds for the shipment of the first container have been given by our sponsoring Church. They have a tremendous vision for missions and are solidly behind us in this work. We thank the Lord for our Church, I assure you. The \$6,000 given so far should be enough not only to ship the container to Bangkok, but pay for moving of literature from the printers in various parts of the USA to Fort Worth where the container will be loaded.

Bangkok...

Plans call for the Gaudet family to move to Bangkok just after the first shipment is made. It will be necessary to rent a building to use to

store the literature. Of course we will also need to rent housing for our family as well as outfitting it with furniture, etc. We estimate setting up in this fashion in Thailand and moving the materials around to the regional countries to cost around \$6,000 in total. Please pray for these needs. I could not imagine starting on an undertaking such as this without many of you interceding. God has proven Himself so many times.



Pray also for our co-laborers in this effort. We will be working closely with the Jeff Lange family in Thailand. This is a young missionary family that has a real vision for Thailand and other parts of Southeast Asia. They are in language training now and are making amazing progress with it. Please



pray for the Lange family and the time we will be allowed to spend with them.

Also, pray for a couple of young ladies who plan to go to Thailand with us. Myra Noel has been working with us for most of the last five years. April Wilson is a young lady from our sponsoring Church who has been working with us in Fort Worth along with her two other sisters. Both of these ladies have handled the typesetting and page layout of these Indochina languages over the past months as we have prepared them for press. Their skills will be invaluable while we are there.

China...
