Greetings...

By the time most of you read this I will have already had surgery to replace my left hip joint. The surgery is slated for June 2. We would certainly appreciate your prayers as I recover from this procedure. The next two months will be interesting for sure.

Of course the work continues. We are currently involved with publishing in several languages, especially those in the middle east. The culmination of a huge project which has been underway for at least 4 years, the Urdu New Testament is being printed as this is written. Please pray for this as well as the distribution of these Scriptures.

As more refugees are admitted to the USA, brethren in churches across the country are responding to the need to reach them. We are often approached by those who wish to get copies of Bibles and evangelistic materials in these languages. Most of the time we are unable to help. Let me explain. Nearly all the Bibles and Scripture portions printed by independent Baptist printing ministries are immediately shipped once they are printed. Most of these go overseas. If there is a need for copies at a later date, they do not have stock.

We are burdened to do something about this situation. Currently we are working on establishing a depot which can handle Bibles, scripture portions, tracts and study materials especially in the languages of people who are currently coming into the USA.

We are days away from taking delivery of a stock of Gospels of John with notes in Arabic. Soon we will have the Urdu New Testaments also. Online ministry:

The ongoing development work on the web based outreach continues. We are populating sites now with interactive studies as well as formatting several foreign language Bibles. All this has taken us quite a bit longer than we originally planned, but then again, what does not work that way? One of our co-workers currently working on a large evangelistic publication in the Hebrew language testifies to the ongoing spiritual battle which oftentimes rages when the enemy stands in opposition.

Please pray as we continue the focus on the unreached multitudes, in the USA and abroad.
