Since Being Home...

Greetings from Texas! Our time here in the USA has been a strange combination of refreshing and challenging. Let me explain. As most of you know we moved to Thailand intending to spend one year. That was 10 years ago. Since the effort in Thailand expanded so rapidly we were only able to make short trips back (2-3 months) during that time. Earlier this year, we had three major projects come to an end about the same time, and the ongoing work did not require direct supervision, thus affording us the opportunity to return to the USA for an extended time.

Upon our arrival here, I began to seek medical help for some problems which had eluded the Dr's in Thailand. That led to a barrage of tests and diagnoses for a particular type of arthritis. I am under treatment for that now. In late July, I was admitted to the hospital for an irregular heartbeat and ended up having a stent put in one artery in my heart.

All that to say we have lost around 4 months of the time we planned use to visit supporting churches. We are trying to make that up now. It is still our intention to visit every one of our supporters during this time in the USA. Please pray for us as we travel.

The Works Goes On

The work goes on however. Another container of Burmese scripture is on the ocean as this is written. I am ordering printing to be done in Nepal, Pakistan, Thailand, and the Philippines. One of our co-workers as well as Nat Williams, a missionary friend in Thailand have graciously handled shipments in our absence. Thank the Lord for those who continue the work.



We are just about to turn over the files for the printing of the Urdu New Testament. I am working with some brethren in printing ministries here to sort out how many copies are needed. Of course these will be shipped to Pakistan when completed. Pray for this effort as it is huge.

Neither time nor space permits me to list every opportunity before us now. The time in the churches and printing ministries has been great for us. Please pray as we continue to travel and the work continues in Thailand and beyond! Thank you for your part in making it all happen.

My favorite holiday is nearly here...Thanksgiving. Unless you want a punch in the nose, do not call it "turkey day." That is one of my pet peeves...calling it turkey day reflects what the world is coming to. A land of people who are ungrateful for the many blessings that the Lord has given to us Americans.

It has been a really wonderful 6 weeks. We were able to see friends that we had not seen in more than 25 years. Boy have they aged! Then I looked in the mirror. I didn't recognize myself either, so I guess we are all in the same boat. Older. However the alternative is, well... some of our old friends have gone to be with the Lord.

I am very thankful to be home in America for this holiday season. It has been quite a few years since we have been home for either Thanksgiving or Christmas and I have missed those times. Have a wonderful Christmas and cherish time with your families.
