



## Youth Olympics outreach:

In past communications with you we have outlined our involvement with this planned outreach during the Youth Olympics, which will be held October 6-18, 2018, Buenos Aires, Argentina. We are involved with the literature for the outreach and a method of follow-up using the internet, but also it looks like (Lord willing) I will be able to join the team on the ground for the first part of the outreach. When we began preparations I certainly did not think it would be possible due to the speed (or lack of it) with which I was recovering from back surgery. Within the past 2-3 weeks, I have improved to the point that I think it possible.

At this point, I have booked tickets and will be traveling on the same flight as a good number of the rest of the team members. I would appreciate prayer for stamina for me during this trip.



The literature specifically prepared for distribution during this outreach is pictured above. It consists of Chick tracts with contact information printed on it. Contact info takes the form of a mailing address, a website address, a QR code, a phone number, and a WhatsApp contact number. That ought to cover it if someone wants to know more about the message of the Gospel! Seriously, please pray that the Word of God will reach those whose hearts He has prepared.

## Internet ministry:

We wish to ask you to pray specifically for key portions of work yet to be done on the Spanish website before the outreach in Argentina. A lot of preparation has been made and intercession dedicated to this effort. Pray for those involved in this great work as well as those in Argentina who will faithfully and prayerfully distribute the message of the Gospel and brethren who will be available to handle the follow-up with those who respond.

The boxes of tracts pictured here were to be part of a larger container shipment of Gospels as well as other helpful materials in Spanish for the missionaries and churches in Argentina. The shipment should not have been a problem, but there arose an issue which could not be resolved in time for the games. After several weeks of brethren there trying to resolve the issue we shifted gears and undertook another approach to get these tracts to the country. This will not fully be resolved until a few days before the games start.

Please, please pray! It might be good to define a word which perfectly pictures the kind of praying needed most at this time. Here is the definition:

1. vigorously active and aggressive, especially in support of a cause:
2. a person engaged in warfare or combat.

The word is **“militant.”** We understand that this word is not normally associated with prayer, but if you were looking from the perspective that we are, we need prayer **warriors**, those who stand strong against the enemy! **Militant intercession!**

A lot of money has been spent printing and shipping these materials. More will be invested in them before they arrive in-country. All of that is fruitless except God intervenes, opening doors and hearts of officials to get the material in.

## From Krinny:

Since our last prayer letter I have had some health issues. I am still not fully recovered from knee replacement that I had in March. Getting in and out of a car is still the most difficult thing that I have trouble with.

I have also had an Echocardiogram and an EKG. These tests showed no problems, but my cardiologist wanted to do a PET scan. The result of that test was that the

doctor said that my heart didn't beat very hard. He said I “may” have a blockage and he wanted to do the test where they thread a catheter into your heart and look around.

I declined this test, because I find it too invasive just to “look around.” My daughter had the answer to my heart

not beating hard enough. She said that if they wanted to make my heart beat harder, they should have thrown a cockroach into the machine with me. Not just any cockroach mind you, but one of those big two inch long ones that can fly. Yep, that would have definitely been the trick to a harder heartbeat. In the mean time I have started riding my stationary bicycle

every morning and getting more exercise, now that I can walk fairly well. Neither Tom nor I have nearly enough stamina since our recent surgeries, so please keep us in your prayers. We are not out of the woods health wise. Pray that as Tom goes to Argentina for the Youth Olympics, that he will have the stamina to hold up.
